The following survey was conducted by OnMessage Inc. in Wisconsin. Telephone interviews were conducted on February 13-16, 2022. This survey consists of 700 likely voters and was stratified to reflect historical voter trends. The margin of error for this survey is +/- 3.70%.




In Wisconsin, the public schools have held on to restrictive COVID policies, like mask mandates, far longer than private schools. It's time to end the COVID restrictions in all schools.





During the COVID pandemic, the teacher's unions demanded lockdowns which led to Wisconsin children falling behind in school.




At times during the COVID pandemic, it seems public school teachers have put their own needs ahead of the 49needs of their students.


Do you generally favor or oppose Wisconsin's School Choice program?


Now I'm going to read you a few things about the Wisconsin School Choice program. For each one please tell me if it makes you more or less likely to support the program.







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
<u>Private schools in the program must follow all safety codes, submit annual audits and match data reporting, including the state test, as public schools before they can accept state vouchers.</u>





SCHOOL CHOICE SAFEGUARDS MORE/LESS LIKELY







Have you or do you know of someone who has considered switching schools for a student in the past year?

Parents should have the right to engage and have their concerns heard with locally elected school board officials in the school district their children are attending, including regularly scheduled school board meetings.

Parents should have the right to review their children's instructional materials and outlines used by the school they are attending.

Wisconsin parents should have the right to send their children to schools that are best for them rather than being forced to attend schools based solely on where they live.




Currently only low-income families are eligible for school choice vouchers in the statewide program. Income restrictions need to be dropped so that every Wisconsin family has the ability to send their children to a school that's best for them.

Parents should have the right to have their children opt-out of a class or instruction for reasons based on either religion or personal conviction.

Charter and choice schools have better academic results compared to public schools yet receive less than two-thirds of the amount of public funding traditional public schools receive. It is time to fully fund charter and choice schools.


