

# WHY ARE PARENTS SO UPSET?

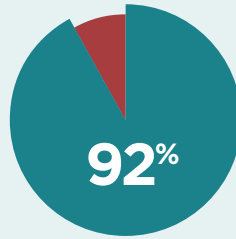
Because politicians like Governor Tony Evers aren't listening to them. The governor vetoed education bills that the majority of Wisconsin residents support. Who will listen to what the people want?

### Parents Bill of Rights

Ensure parent's right to voice concerns to local school board meetings

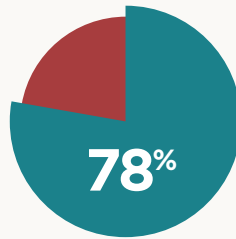


## ASSEMBLY BILL 488 & SB 463

### Curriculum Transparency

Requires school districts to give parents transparency in curriculum

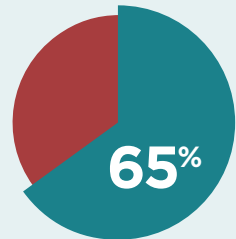


## SENATE BILL 970

### School Choice for All Families

Gives all families the right to choose private schools through the Wisconsin Parental Choice Program
