# SCWA KEY ISSUE OF THE MONTH: **ACCOUNTABILITY**

Opponents mistakenly claim that private schools in Wisconsin operate free of regulation. This is untrue for private schools in general and especially so for schools in the state's choice program.

Choice schools are more accountable than public schools—**parent choice and the freedom to switch schools produces real accountability.** For most Wisconsin parents, the only choice is determined by their zip code.

Private schools in choice programs must...

- Administer the same state assessments as public schools;
- Publish their data in the State Accountability Report Card;
- Undergo four annual audits ensuring financial transparency;
- Achieve independent accreditation;
- Comply with many other state requirements.

All in all, SCWA seeks to bring awareness to these accountability measures to prevent any misinformation regarding the validity of private schools in the programs. Click here to learn more about accountability.

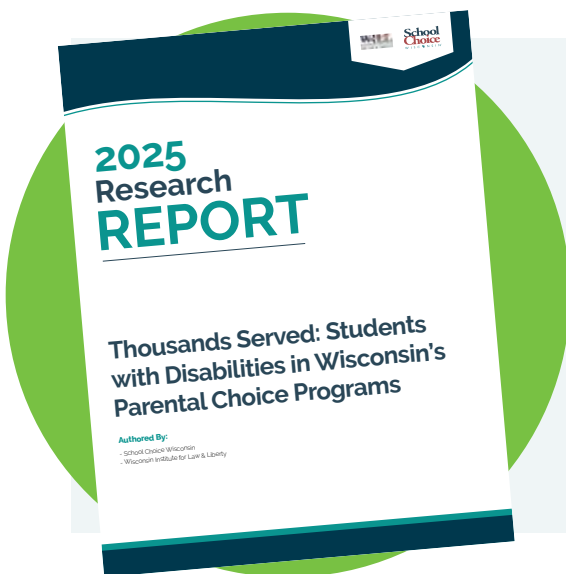
