



## Growth & Opportunity Ahead

The Department of Public Instruction just released new data showing historic growth in the state's private school parental choice programs, which are now serving more than **60,000** students across four programs. With the statewide enrollment

cap set to lift in 2026-27, we are hopeful this momentum will continue to expand opportunities for even more Wisconsin families.

While the cap expiration will bring changes to how the statewide program enrollment operates, SCW will be there to assist however we can.
